Background:

The Pottsville Community Association Inc (PCA) was formed in 1988 to represent the residents and ratepayers of Pottsville and its environs. The PCA liaises closely with all spheres of government to address matters affecting the Pottsville community. PCA has representatives on many Tweed Shire Council Advisory Committees and within some government bodies.

PCA works harmoniously with the Pottsville Chamber of Commerce and the Pottsville Beach Neighbourhood Centre in fostering community spirit and enterprise.

Membership:

Membership is open to all residents and ratepayers in the Pottsville region for a small fee. Committed community members join the Association to:

- Coordinate community opinion;
- Lobby all levels of government;
- Push for resources and action to adequately safeguard this community;
- Collectively and passively combat vandalism and other anti-social acts;
- Assist with operations like "Clean Up Australia";
- Actively seek community partnerships for the benefit of residents and ratepayers.

Monthly Meetings:

Monthly meetings are held on the last Tuesday of each month (except in December when there is no meeting) at the Pottsville Community Hall (located on Coast Road – next to the sports oval) from 7:45pm.

These meetings are often attended by guest speakers from the community, or government departments.

Supper is provided after each meeting, and there is a chance to win a free door prize. A bargain table is sometimes available as a fundraiser.
